1. Entries shall be presented in safe working order.
2. All entries shall be insured against third party risks.
3. Vehicle owners shall ensure that drivers are fully competent and qualified in law to operate the vehicle.
4. No tractor or exhibit shall be left unattended whilst running.
5. Entrants and exhibitors shall pay full regard to the instructions of the organisers and stewards and conduct themselves in a manner that will not inconvenience or endanger other people at any time.
6. All dogs shall be kept on a lead on the showground and ploughing field.

Declaration: Unsigned entries cannot be accepted.

1. I/we declare that during the whole period of the event, my/our entry will be covered by a public liability policy of insurance (including use on public roads) having a limit of indemnity of not less than £1,000,000 for any one incident.
2. I/we declare that although the event takes place wholly off the Public Highway, the vehicle hereby entered is covered by insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act 1960, which is valid for travelling to this event on roads or in public places as defined by the Act.
